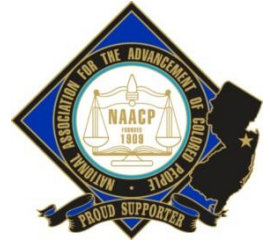

Dear Prosecutor:

The Asbury Park/Neptune (NAACP) formally request meeting with you to discuss, within limits of the investigative process, the current citizen's allegations complaining of voter intimidation; voter suppression, the actions, conduct, and demeanor of members, sent from your office, while encountering citizens in Asbury Park; in their homes and on the city streets.

We beseech this meeting on amicable terms; as we, The Asbury Park/Neptune (NAACP) do not embrace an accusatory posture in light of this matter. Collateral to your investigation we are merely seeking dialogue affable in address of the citizenry complaints resulting in the percepts of voter intimidation, voter suppression, and the discouragement of Asbury Park residents respective to their constitutional voting process of rights.

At posthaste notice, we are requesting the convening of this meeting on Friday, May 10, 2013; at 5:15PM. This specific hour purely in order to afford The Asbury Park/Neptune (NAACP) officers time to complete their workday, travel to, and attend this assembly. If you are amenable to this invitation, meeting at your satellite office in Asbury Park in convenient.

Additionally, with hopeful discussion, all parties in a responsible time period can address this matter with interlocutory resolution within the community of Asbury Park; prior to the May 14, 2013 Asbury Park city council elections.
